2023 SECOND QUARTER TARIFF REVIEW DECISION FOR WATER SERVICES

The Public Utilities Regulatory Commission (PURC) has concluded the Quarterly Tariff Reviews for the second quarter of 2023 as part of its regulatory mandate. The review has resulted in the Commission approving changes in water tariffs for the second quarter of 2023. This takes effect from June 01, 2023.

In taking this decision, the Commission took cognisance of the cost of electricity, increased volume/cost of chemicals for raw water treatment, the Ghana Cedl/US Dollar exchange rate, and inflation.
